


Happy New Year to all SHARC Members!

The Hunt will take place at Crews Lake Park off of Lenway Road in Pasco County. We will meet in the parking lot near Shelter #1 I have attached a map of the park so you can find the shelter.

For those of you who are new to Fox Hunting, in its simplest form all you need is a 2 meter handheld radio. We will have some equipment available for use and Larry W95X and I will be there to coach first time hunters. The transmitter will be transmitting on 147.510 and withing a reasonable radius of the parking lot. Dress for the weather and wear comfortable walking shoes and be prepared to have fun. 
